Entry to ADFA is open to sailors of SMN (Qualified) through Warrant Officer rank, can be appointed as officers to undertake full-time undergraduate study at UNSW Canberra

Rank on entry (SMN and Able Seaman only):

All successful candidates will be appointed as B/MIDN O/P (00) and will normally remain in that rank (with appropriate seniority increments for each year of successful completion of degree studies) for the duration of their degree studies.

Rank on entry (Leading Seaman through Warrant Officer only):

All successful candidates will be appointed as either Acting Sub-Lieutenant (O1), Sub-Lieutenant (O2) or Lieutenant (O2) (appointment rank is dependent on sailor rank at the time of appointment) while under taking a three or four year undergraduate degree at ADFA candidates will normally remain in that rank for the duration of their degree studies.

Primary qualifications available:

DAE/SEA candidates may be entered in one of the following officer PQ:

1. Maritime Warfare Officer (MWO);
2. Pilot (P);
3. Aviation Warfare Officer (AVWO);,
4. Supply Officer (SU);
5. Aeronautical Engineer (AE);
6. Mechanical Engineer (ME);
7. Weapons Electrical Engineering (WEE); or
8. Weapons Electrical Aircraft Engineering (WEA)
